Note: At least three certifying ISA officials are required for a world record. One official observer must be on-site. Discipline-specific records require judges rated in that discipline. FAA-rated pilots may ONLY certify exit altitude and most jumps in a 24-hour period record claims. For large formation records, a plan of the jump and a list of participants must be submitted to the observing judge before the jump; the formation must be completed as planned.
